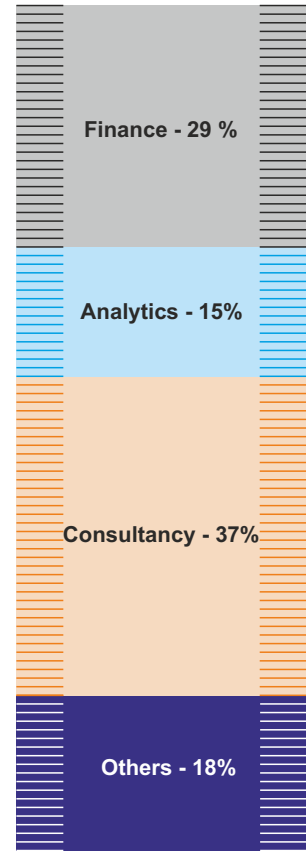
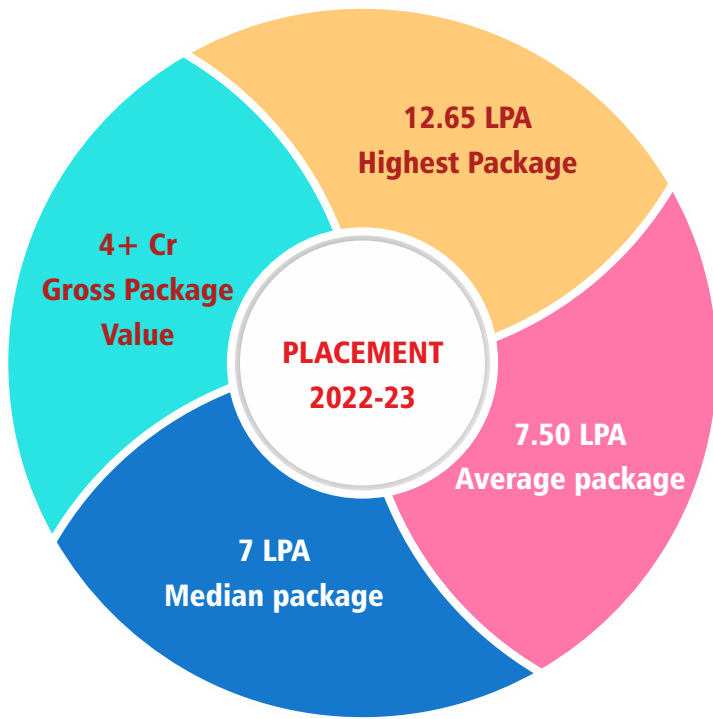

# STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM



Symbiosis School of Economics courses are benchmarked with the leading international universities. With multiple Memorandum of Understanding under its belt, SIU offers its students numerous opportunities to collaborate and study abroad for a single semester. This program consistently witnesses a high number of applicants every semester. The credits the students attain while studying abroad are then transferred to SSE with approval from the Symbiosis Centre for International Education, further permitting students to map their courses and the equivalent credits.





## WHY RECRUIT US

**Core Courses:** Students at SSE are exposed to a rigorous environment where they study courses in all aspects of Economics at both Bachelor's and Master's Level. The inclusion of interdisciplinary subjects like finance, Development Studies, International Trade, Urban Development, and policy analysis makes students at both levels well-versed with the theory as well as recent developments in the real world.

**International Exposure:** As a part of Symbiosis International University, students at SSE are eligible for the Student Exchange programs post-completion of one year at SSE.

**IT Skills:** All of the courses incorporate a wide array of project work: Students undertake various projects using a range of programs like SPSS, Stata, R, Excel, and TORA.

**Practical Exposure:** Students undertake two Summer Internships. Thus, by the time they graduate, a student enrolled in the BSc(Hons) program and MSc. has a minimum of 2 months of experience

**Quantitative Skills:** Every student at SSE compulsorily studies courses in Statistics, Mathematical Economics, and Econometrics. There are advanced optional subjects for students in Mathematical Economics, Econometrics & Operations Research.

**Specializations/Optional:** Students at the Bachelor's level are provided options to undertake Liberal Arts Courses like Financial Law, Cyber Laws, Foreign languages (Spanish, French & German), Advanced Mathematical Economics, Advanced Econometrics, Operations Research, Agricultural Economics, and Behavioural Economics.

**Writing and Articulation Skills:** All students complete a course in Economic Journalism and Research Methodology where they are taught the nuances of writing and structuring their thoughts. Every student at SSE undertakes a dissertation in their final year which helps them to apply their learning to a live research project of their choice.

**People Skills:** Students are in charge of the numerous co-curricular activities at SSE like the College fest, social service, and sports. They organize events, procure sponsors and ensure participation from other colleges.
