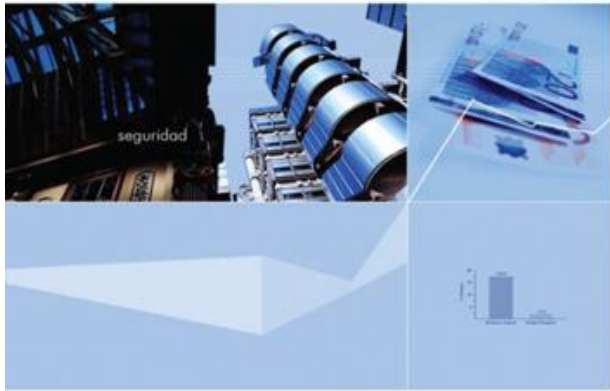
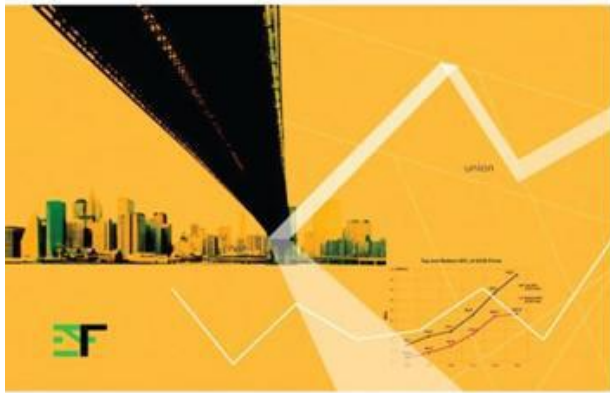

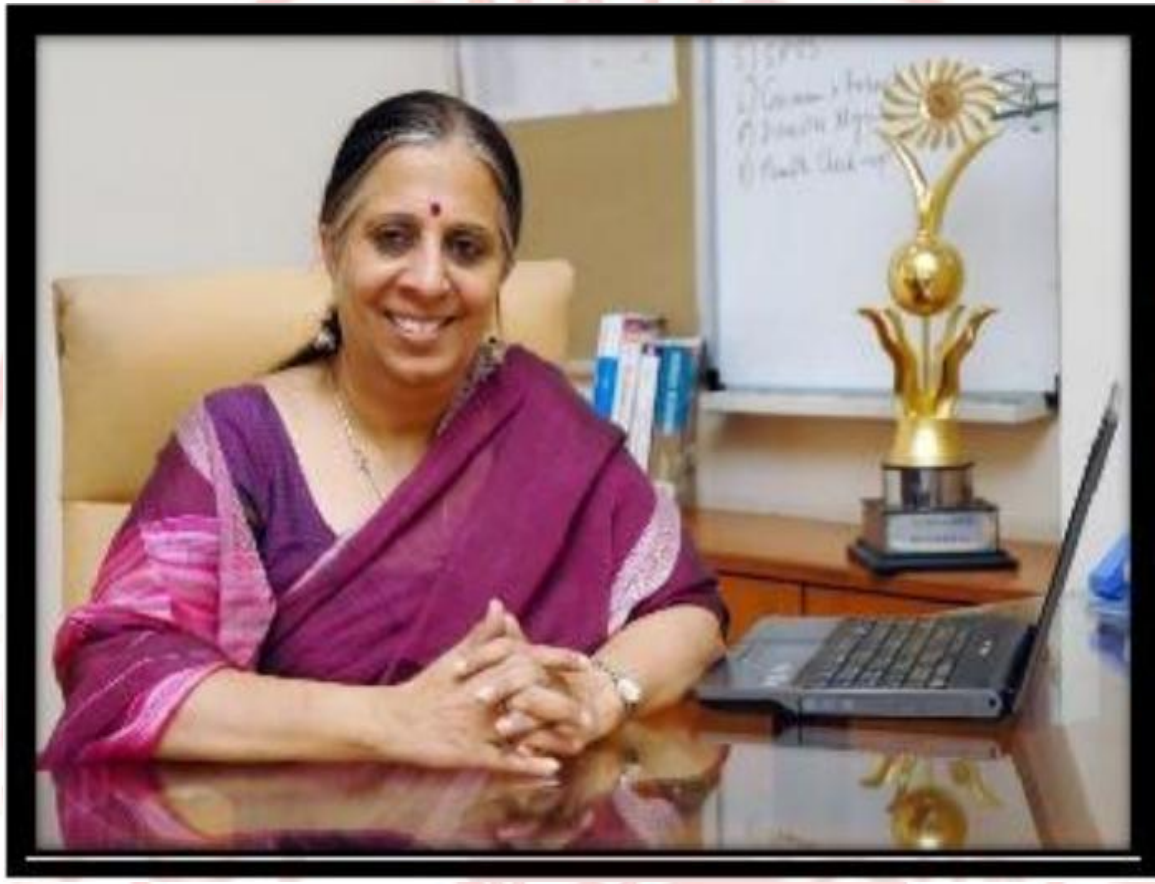

Students are selected on the basis of academic merits, SNAP(optional) group discussion and personal interview.

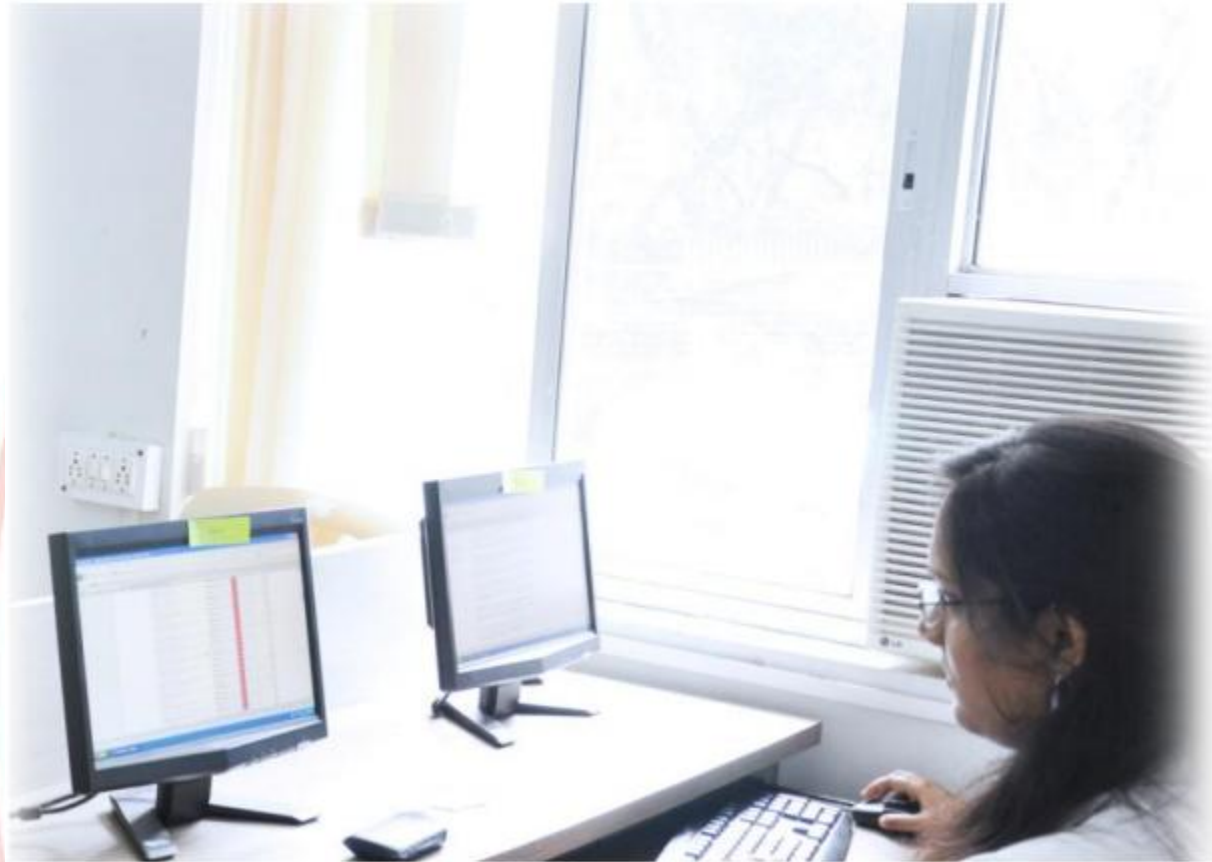
## INFRASTRUCTURE

Located in the heart of Pune, on Senapati Bapat Road, the Symbiosis International University campus is home to the Symbiosis School of Economics, along with Symbiosis Law School, Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce, Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences, Symbiosis College and Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts. This rich mix of different specializations affords our students an opportunity to interact with ideas and methods they probably would not have come across from isolated colleges.



Though not expansive in size, the college has been able to acquire impressive infrastructure, and continues to bring about new inclusions to the college building. The classrooms all come equipped with Wi-Fi accessibility, projectors for presentations and videos, surround sound systems and computers with analytical software, to give our students a

more interactive and digital learning experience and also enables the professors to use different media while imparting knowledge.



The college has a computer lab for itself which is capable of internet browsing, to help our students in their research along with a comprehensive library. The machines in the computer laboratory are also equipped with programs such as SPSS and SSE is in talks with SAS India to include SAS as well; to help our students in the economic modeling and research papers that are a requisite in the Semester II. This ensures that our students are capable of using analytic software that is in line with the requirements of major firms.

Besides these, SSE also has health and recreational facilities for the students that include cafeteria, mess, gymnasium, hostel, auditorium and a cultural arts museum with the other colleges based on the campus.



## **WHY RECRUIT AT SSE?**

The program curriculum in each of our courses is designed by experienced faculty after considering the course curriculum of various reputed colleges and universities around the world. The program lays the foundation for conceptual and analytical economic reasoning. It seeks to provide an insight into the dynamics of the corporate world through applied case studies, seeking summer training at various business enterprises as a requirement for finishing the course. The curriculum and the college atmosphere promote inquisition, innovation, leadership and team-spirit. Apart from possessing a clear understanding of the fundamentals of economic theory as well as application, there also exists a considerable degree of corporate exposure, which makes our students resourceful and versatile.

### **Research Writing Workshop**

Students of M.Sc have to compulsorily undergo Research Writing Workshop conducted by Prof. Shirin Tejani, who is an alumnus of London School of Economics. The workshop is conducted with the aim of guiding our students to write professional research papers, research reports and other research related literature. Students are subject to rigorous exercise of data analysis, research writing via various assignments and are awarded “Certificate of Participation” only on completion of all the assignments. The concerned faculty ensures that the assignments undertaken are of high standards.

## **Internships**

After the end of each of the first year at SSE, our students have to compulsorily undertake internships as part of the course requirement. This ensures that students who pass out from SSE not only have in-depth knowledge of theory at work but also see and apply it on a hands-on, real-time basis. The students would be exposed to the practical aspects of their areas of specialization that would add to the education imparted in the classroom to make our students professional and efficient workers.

## **Interaction with Leading Economists and Thinkers**

Through the various workshops organized throughout the year at SSE, the students have had the ability to call upon the trials and victories of many established individuals. This has imparted invaluable insight to the students who are now better equipped to handle trials of their own. 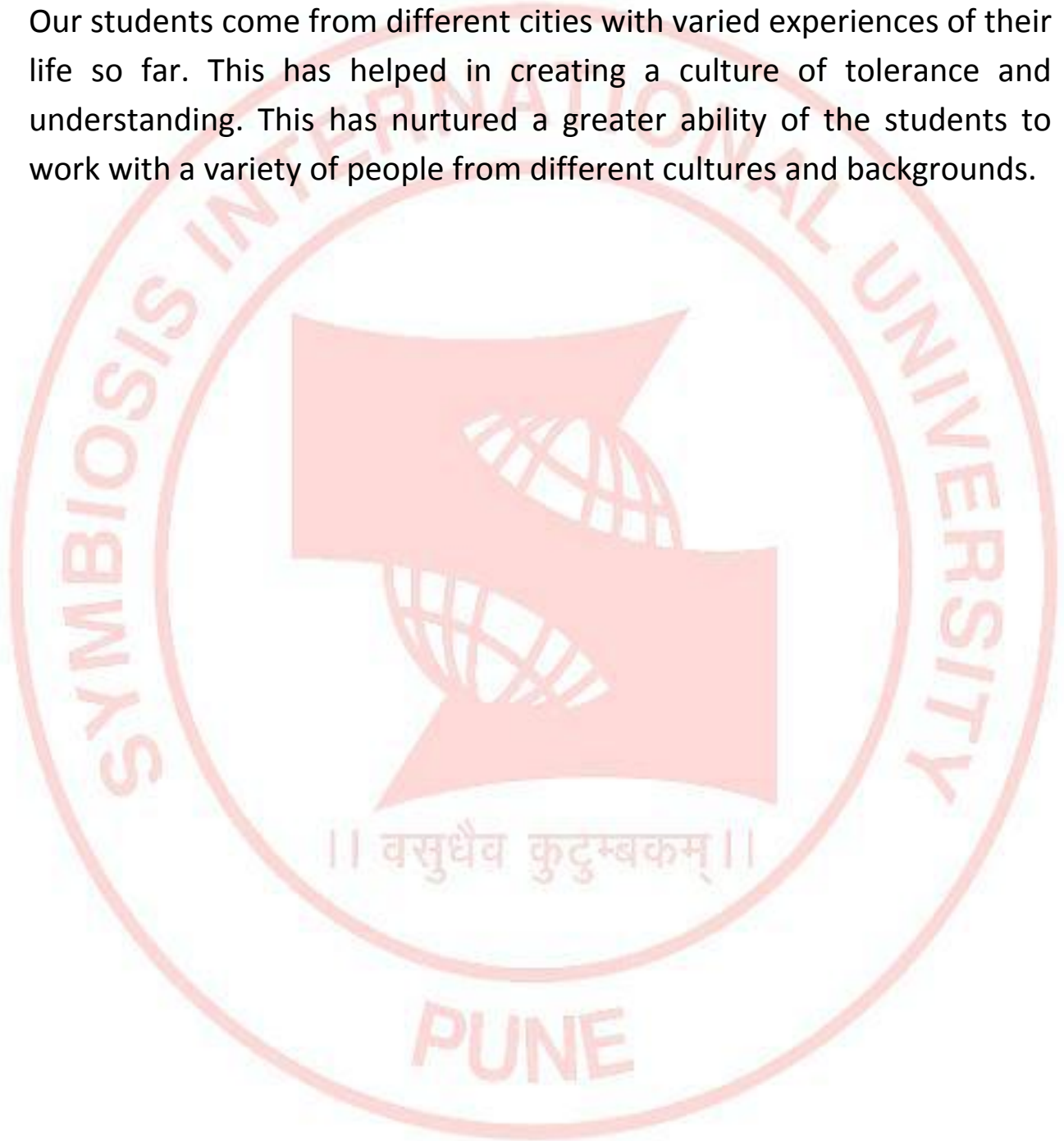

### **Mixing of a diverse student population**

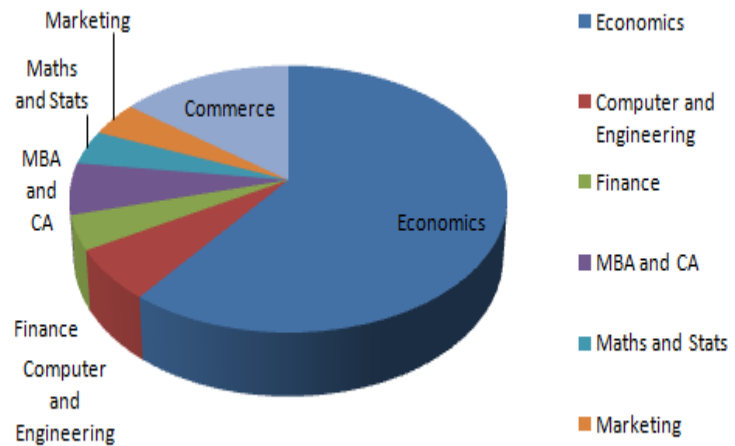

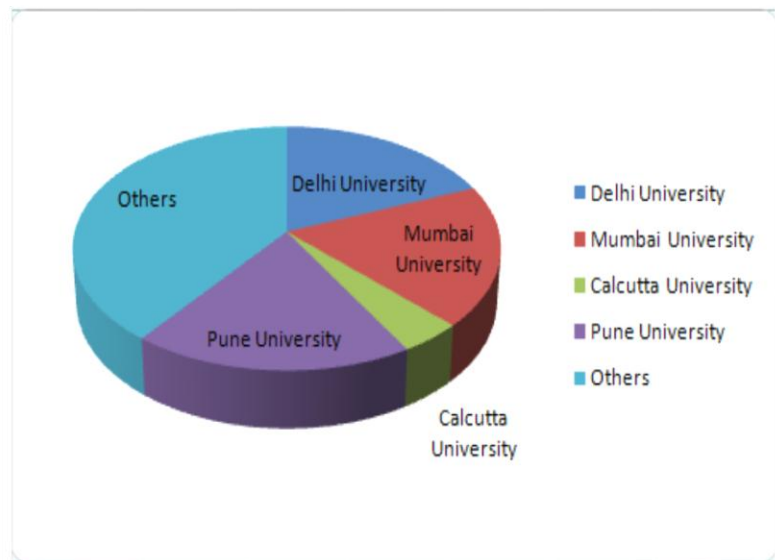

## Background of the students

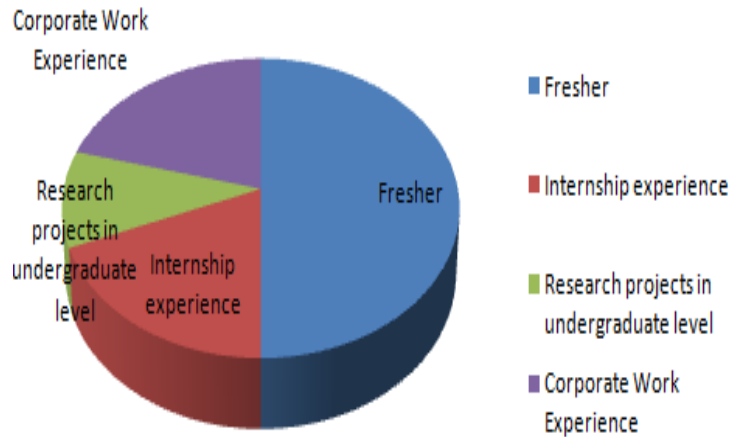
