# Academic Programme

## Admission Procedure:

- 12th pass from any stream with minimum 50% marks for general category and 45% for students of SC and ST category.
- Qualifying the Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) and group discussion and personal interview of the School.

All the Indian students are required to take the Symbiosis Entrance test (SET). SET is an examination that students must take to be eligible to seek admission to the degree programmes of Symbiosis International University (SIU). Since the degree programmes are offered under different faculties of SIU, the appropriate category of the SET must be taken.

## B.Sc. Programme

The course (B.Sc. Economics) offered at SSE is meant to provide a foundation in Economics theory and practice as it includes diverse subjects such as Mathematics, Statistics, Finance, Law, Environment, Journalism and politics. It is a foundation for students who wish to do the post-graduation course in Economics. The course also provides a base to career opportunities in various industries requiring macro and micro analysis, such as Financial institutions, Media and communication, Government agencies, Research and Academia.

The B.Sc. (Economics) course offered is a full time, three year graduation programme. It aims at creating a programme structure that incorporates, traditional as well as modern approaches to Economics.

The programme offers a wide array of courses such as Business Laws, Environmental Economics, International Relations, Political Economy of India , Research Methodology etc., which traditional Economics graduation programmes do not usually include in their curriculum. This helps students get an edge over other graduates, in terms of critical thinking, logical analysis and deeper understanding of crucial economic issues. Students at SSE actively participate in Co-curricular and Extra co-curricular activities such as Public Speaking; film Making, Choreography, Sports, Music, Social Work, Environment and Theatre.

The programme structure gives the freedom to the students to avail an assortment of courses. Some of the students may choose to undertake student exchange programme, under global immersion programme of SIU. The other students opt for 4 credits through Inter-Institute Credit Transfer System (opting courses offered by other UG institutes of SIU). They are also required to take 2 courses under liberal art education like Creative Writing, Mentioning Unmentionable, An Enquiry into Freedom, Cyber Law, etc. of their interest & an additional 4 credits for Service Centre Learning, which helps the students to gain first hand practical experience of working with NGO's & other organizations. This exposes the students to a 360 degree learning perspective and facilitates all round development of their personalities.

# Certificate Courses and Collaborations

## Certificate Courses

### Corporate Social Responsibility

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) is the ability of a business firm to contribute back to the society and share its profits with the needy, on issues pertaining to social and environmental relevance. It is meant to provide voice and choice to the unheard and unseeked. It helps the business to take into account and make up, for the various implications of its actions on different segments of society, thereby allowing it to help serve society better. This course helps the students to discover ways in which profits of business can and should be shared with the deprived, to address various causes of local, national and international importance.

### Quantitative Economics

The course in Quantitative Economics (QE) gives greater knowledge into mathematical tools that are used for analysis of problems given everyday situations. It is deciphering and interpreting the facts and numerical data to evolve probable solutions. This adds to the repertoire of an analytical mind, sharpening it and focusing it on the task at hand. It involves learning of mathematical skills of Masters I level to students who feel they have flair for quantitative approach to economics.

### SAS

SAS software is business intelligence tool that is used in as much as 90% of the top seeded companies, on the Fortune 500 list for the year 2011. By enabling the students to become certified users of this software, SSE hopes to enable them to provide for current and future business needs with the power of SAS business computing. This is a certificate course available to Third Year students of B.Sc. and M.Sc. Economics.

### National Stock Exchange

The National Stock Exchange (NSE) has partnered with SSE to provide a certificate course for the students, which certifies their ability as brokers/ traders on the stock market. This course evidences that the students possess the same skill sets as those on the market floor and are competitive to the same extent, and are able to understand the flows and ebbs of the market in motion on a normal business day.

### **OMG (Ontario-Maharashtra-Goa) Program**

A consortium of universities in Ontario, Canada and in the states of Maharashtra and Goa, have initiated a student exchange program to enrich the quality of students. ### **CII**

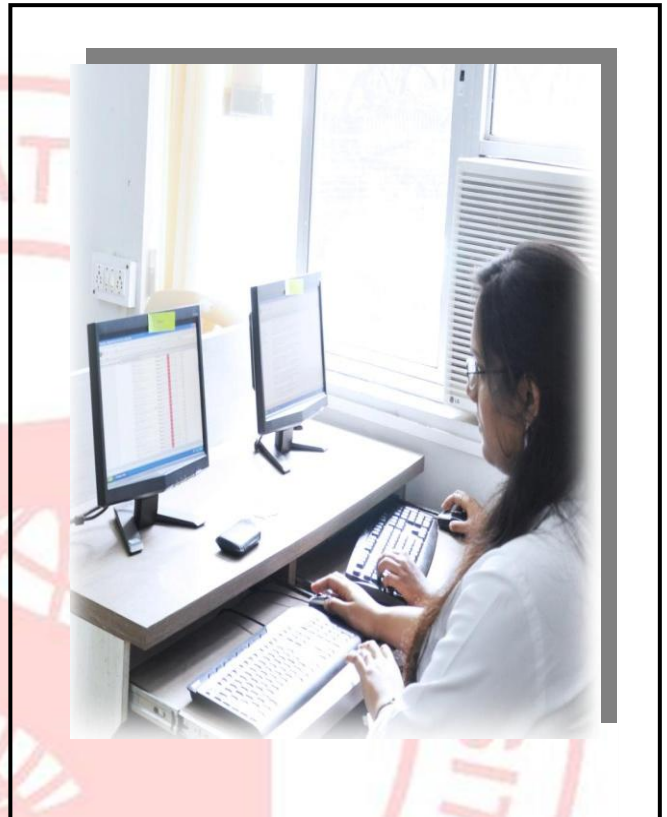

# **Host: National Conference on Urban Policy and Planning**

## **National Conference on Urban Policy and Planning**

A veritable treasure trove of the brightest minds, in both the academic and policy making sphere were seen in Pune on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> of February, 2011, to discuss the art and craft of planning a city. This was a meeting of the brightest minds from the length and breadth of India, to discuss and offer insights to the students as to how to plan the cities and legislations for a sustainable tomorrow. As the future lawmakers listened intently, there was much debate and explanation on what does a city truly require out of its municipal bodies and how best to achieve them. For this, the Pune Municipal Corporation was an active partner in the discussion.

The goals of the conference were to find answers to questions such as ‘What is sustainable city planning?’, and also asking what measures must any citizen take in order to improve the functioning of any aspect of his city. ‘Is there a thought process that any such citizen might follow?’, ‘to what extent is the civic body responsible, and what are the required duties of a citizen?’ were all central philosophies of the discussion. There was also a deep introspection about the policies that are currently in place, regarding the various infrastructural bodies in place. The final question put forward to the experts was how they envision the growing city of Pune 20 years down the line.

### *Areas of Focus*

To better analyze the various aspects of city planning, the conference was divided into a number of segments, all with the prime goal of better understanding the micro aspects involved in the planning of a city. The conference was broken down to six segments, highlighting the needs of the power generation and distribution sector, availability of water and its supply, the different approaches to urban transportation and their analysis, the problems of the everyday pedestrian user, the requirement of efficient methods of solid waste disposal and issues of land and the policies currently in play in the zoning of land, as well as the real estate sector.

Ms. Dhawan was invited to deliver a lecture on the prevailing conditions in her current job profile, i.e. the floor of the London Stock Exchange, and exchange with the students her experience on trade capital of the world economy. The session was covered over two lectures scheduled weeks apart, the first of which was a discussion on the exchange market and the terms and jargon used, while also revealing her various experiences on the trading ground. The second of these lectures was used to engage the students in a real-time news based game, wherein the students, split into groups, represented various sections of the market, such as the supply side, the buy side, the industries, etc. This exercise allowed the students to get a real time feel of how the stock market reacts and seeks to stabilize itself after shocks and how each side seeks to further its own interests while trying to function in a stable economy.

## **Human Capital**

Specialized in global business strategies, Professor Iyer gave a talk on 'Human Capital as a Catalyst for Change in the Globalised Environment'. ## Internships

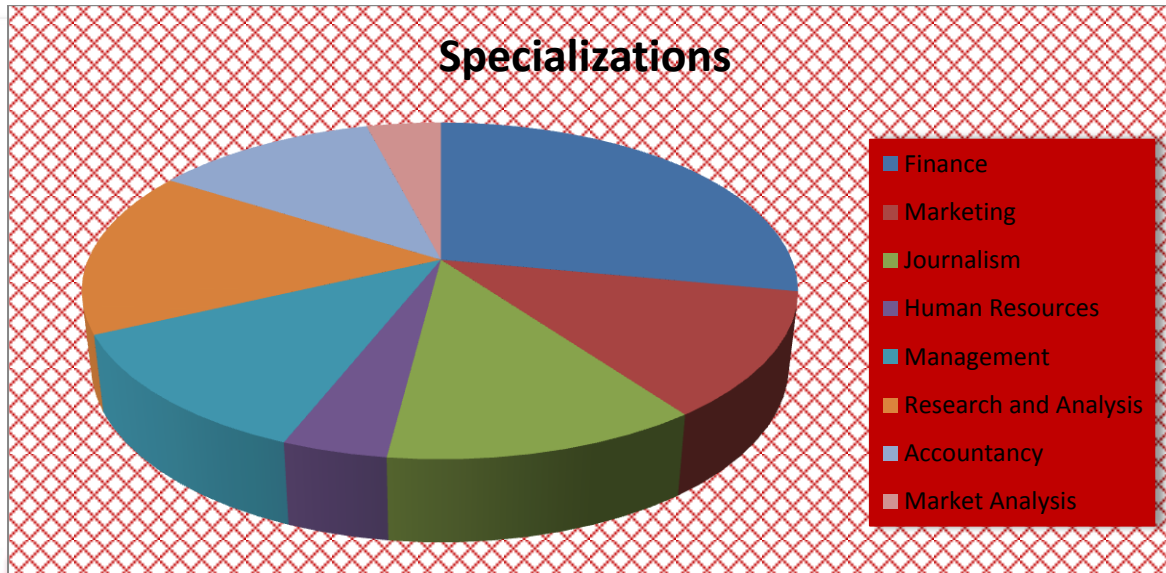

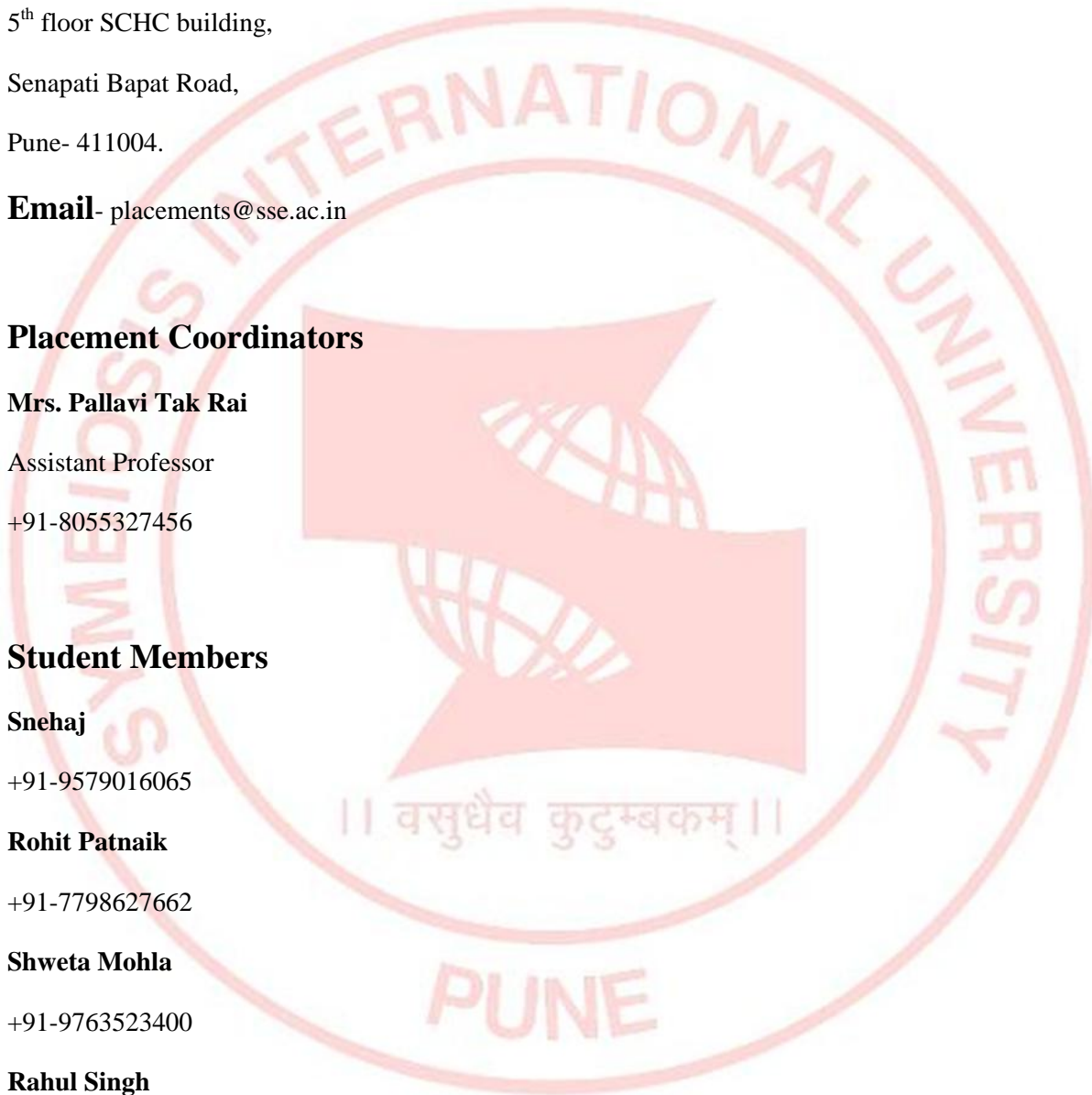

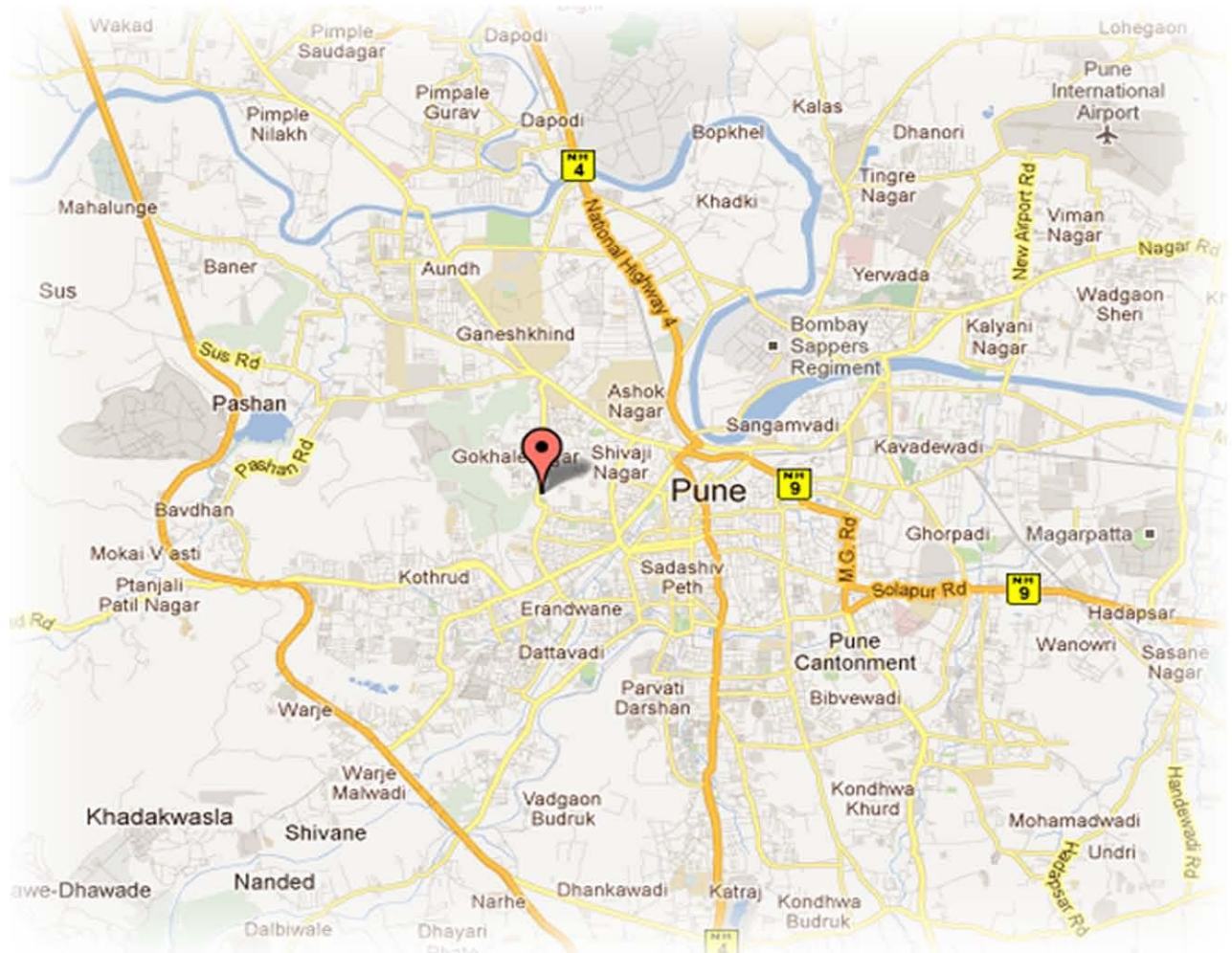
