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
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Action Taken Report for Academic Year 2020-2021

Sr. No.	Particulars / Action Point	Action Taken
1	Revision in existing courses and electives.	<p>1) In Sem III – Research Methodology to be introduced as a 4 credit course instead of Law and Economics which will be shifted to Sem V.</p> <p>2) Sem IV – Replaced Research Methodology a 4 credit course which has been shifted to the third semester, with IT Applications, a 2 credit course. This has been carried out to prepare the students for corporate internships after forth semester.</p> <p>3) Sem V – Law and Economics to be offered as a 4 credit course in Sem V and syllabus to be revised.</p> <p>4) Sem V – Economic Journalism to be also offered as a 4 credit course in semester V for those who choose Industrial Organization (3 credit) as an optional course. The students can make a choice wrt – Micro III and Macro III – 2 credits each – 4 credits total, Theory of Political Economy in India (4 credits), Industrial Organization (3 credits). The students who opt for Industrial Organization (3 credits) they will have to take Economic Journalism as a 4 credit course.</p> <p>The objective of the above changes is to offer additional electives and address the student's suggestions wrt Micro III and Macro III.</p>
